

Safety Regulations

TOP OF ADVENTURE



For safety reasons, the First Flyer, First Glider, Mountain Cart and Trottibike Scooter are not suitable for people with hypertension, neck or bone injuries, nor people who are pregnant, suffer from heart complaints, or people who have had a recent operation, or who have a physical or mental disability. Access is prohibited to people under the influence of alcohol.





First Flyer and First Glider rules



- First Flyer: Persons using this must weigh between 35 kg and 125 kg.
- First Glider: Minimum height 130 cm, with a maximum weight of 125kg



- Shoes must be worn during the descent.

Emergency number 144



In the event of accidents, the accident site must be secured and first aid administered to the injured person(s). Alert the rescue service by telephoning 144. The injured person(s) should not be left alone.

Contractual terms


- By signing below, the hirer confirms, after having completed a handling and brake test, that he/she has been given a properly maintained Mountain Cart or Trottibike Scooter.
- The undersigned must ensure that any underage persons accompanying him/her are also aware of the rules.
- The costs for rectifying any damage caused by the improper use of any equipment will be invoiced on site or subsequently.
- No liability can be accepted for lost items.
- If the rescue service of the mountain railway has to be summoned in the case of an accident, a maximum of CHF 250.- will be billed to the customer. Thirdparty costs are at the expense of the customer. Claims for a refund from an accident insurance are matter of the customer.















Mountain Cart and Trottibike Scooter rules



- Minimum height Trottibike Scooter: 125cm Cart: 135cm.
- Safety helmets must be worn.
- Climbing out of the cart is prohibited during the descent.



- Steer and brake using both hands. Do not use items like a selfie stick or mobile phone during your descent.
- Shoes must be worn during the descent.
- Mountain Carts and Trottibike Scooters may only be used on the officially marked route.
- User must adapt their driving style and speed (max. 30 km/h) to the terrain, their own driving skills and the presence of other road users. Oncoming traffic must be expected. Please use the passing place.
- Road safety rules must be observed, in particular users must drive on the right and always maintain a safe stopping distance of half the observable distance from the Mountain Cart or Trottibike Scooter ahead.
- Trottibike Scooter and cart drivers must be considerate towards pedestrians and give them right of way.
- As the marked downhill route is part of the general road and path route network, it has no special safety measures nor is it specifically monitored.
- Expect to encounter bumps, potholes, debris and, depending on the weather conditions, wetness.
- A maximum time limit of 45 minutes applies to each downhill trip.
- A minimum of CHF 30.- will be payable in the event of wilful destruction (i.e. damage to tyres caused by emergency braking).
- Only one person per vehicle is permitted.
- The Trottibike Scooter is to be returned to the Firstbahn valley station, and the Cart to Bort station.
